Friendship week

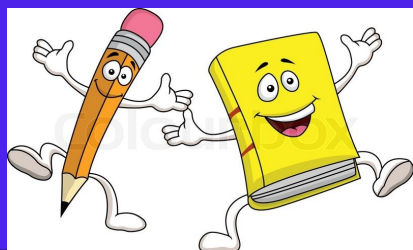
